- a) A cover letter including names and contact information of two confidential referees and your medical practitioner, and any information relevant to your application that does not fit on the form.
- b) A one-page account of your response to the desire of the church to call you to ordained ministry in the PGM Church.
- c) Your current curriculum vitae includes your employment record, educational and training awards, and indications of experience relevant to your being considered for pastoral leadership in the Church.
- d) Two written references from people (other than those in (a) above) who have known you in positions of responsibility in the church and employment or study.
- e) Two recent passport-size photographs.
- f) Certified copies of academic transcripts and photocopies, not originals, of all tertiary awards and training course certificates. (Originals should be sighted by one of the Elders who will sign the photocopies. Or by a Justices of the Peace)
